

Student Services Healthcare Education Funding Reforms

Students on Part Time Courses

For certain part-time undergraduate pre-registration healthcare programmes commencing between 1 August 2017 and 31 July 2018, maintenance bursaries are being made available. As part of the transitional arrangements for these types of programmes, a capping arrangement has been established. The following universities and programmes have a capped allocation for places that will attract a maintenance bursary.

Students who are awarded a capped place will be eligible to apply for a tuition fee loan from Student Finance England. In order to receive a maintenance bursary, students must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Awarded a capped place on an eligible programme
- Ordinarily resident in England
- In receipt of a tuition fee loan from Student Finance England

If you are studying on one of these courses, you will need to create a new account on the Bursary Online Support System (BOSS).
