Community Pharmacy Seasonal Influenza Vaccination Advanced Service

- 15. A fee of £7.98 will be paid for each adult flu vaccination administered by a pharmacy contractor. An additional fee of £1.50 will be paid to cover training and clinical waste costs associated with the vaccination.
- 16. Pharmacy contractors will be reimbursed the cost of the vaccine in accordance with Part II, Clause 8C (Basic Price) of the Drug Tariff. An allowance at the applicable VAT rate will also be paid.
- 17. The fees will be payable only to contractors meeting the requirements of the service. These are set out in directions 7A and 7B of the principle Directions and the service specification.
- 18. Claims should be submitted to the NHS BSA via either the paper claim form or the webform provided by the NHS BSA (but not both). Claims will be accepted by the NHS BSA within six months of administration of the vaccination. Later claims will not be processed. Payments* to contractors will be made monthly as part of their normal payment schedule. The paper claim form, the webform and information on submitting a claim are available via the NHS BSA website (https://www.nhsbsa.nhs.uk/pharmacies-gp-practices-and-appliance-contractors/dispensing-contractors-information/community-1). Paper claims must be submitted to the NHSBSA with the FP34C each month. The NHS BSA will send a unique url (link) to the webform to all community pharmacy premises' shared NHSmail accounts on a monthly basis. If using the webform for submitting claims, contractors should ensure that they only make a single claim for each calendar month, as subsequent submissions for that claim month will not be accepted by the webform.
